HPV Intervention Research in an Integrated Healthcare Delivery System

Learning Objectives

- To provide participants with an understanding of HPV vaccine intervention research being conducted within the Kaiser Permanente Northwest system.

Summary

This presentation will describe the portfolio of HPV vaccine intervention research conducted over the past several years at Kaiser Permanente Northwest, an integrated healthcare delivery system providing care to nearly 610,000 members in Oregon and Southwest Washington. We will summarize key findings from three recently completed intervention studies including (1) an assessment and feedback intervention designed to improve HPV vaccination rates in KPNW pediatric and family medicine departments, (2) an intervention to encourage KPNW dental providers to assess adolescent vaccination care gaps and recommend vaccines, and (3) a pilot study of a vaccination “comfort menu” intervention designed to improve the vaccination experience for adolescents and reduce the risk of adverse events such as injection site pain and syncope.
